

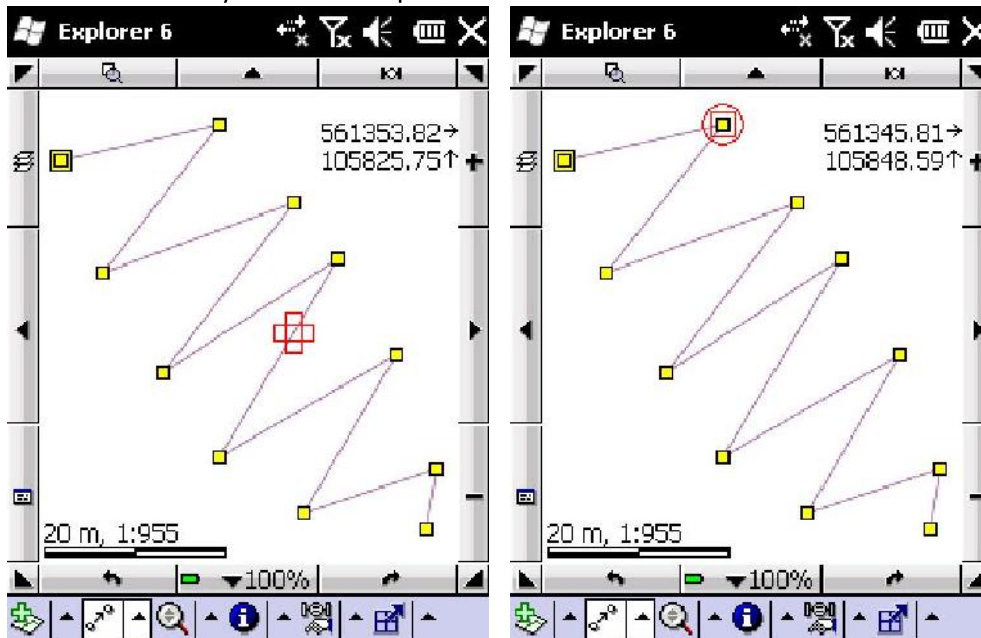
II. Splitting polyline features manually

The new version of DigiTerra Explorer contains a new button called “Splitting Polyline” on the **New vertex** and on the **Existing vertex** dialog boxes, that can be accessed by using the **Edit vertex > Edit tool** in the Edit menu.

The **Splitting Polyline button** is used to manually split one polyline into two at the location you tap on the screen.

1. Select the Edit vertex > Edit tool
2. Click on the line you want to split into two



3. Double tap at the location you want to split the line than tap on the Splitting Polyline button.

The split command updates the shape of the existing line feature and creates two new features using the default attribute values for the feature class. You can change the attribute values in the desktop version after the splitting immediately. In the mobile version use the Identify tool and then open the Record panel to modify the attributes of each feature.
